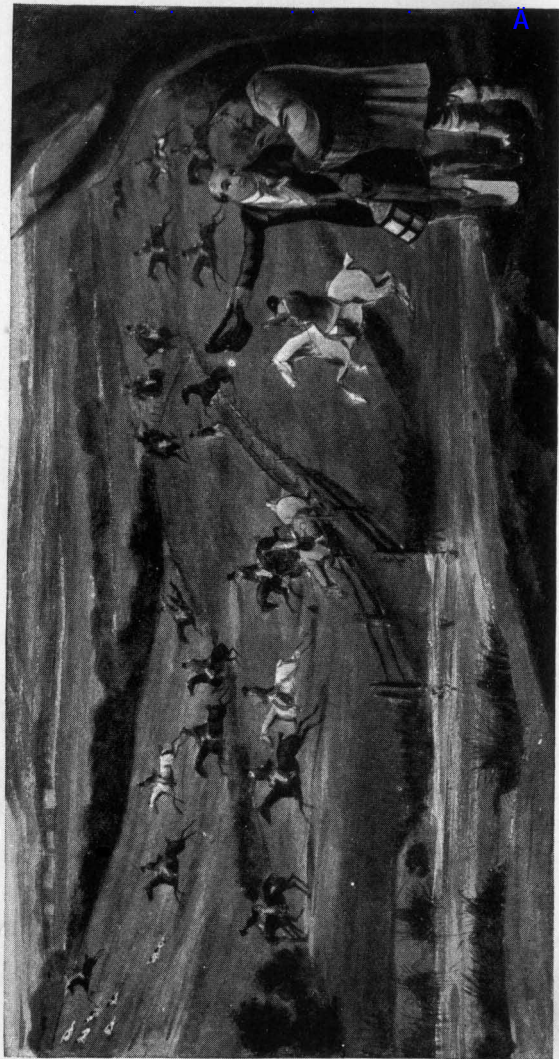
ENGLISH FOX HUNTING

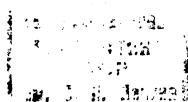
